


Chithramathil back to life

hithramathil, one of the longest outdoor cement mural in the country, has been given a burnish, thanks to a group of students at the Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit.

The work of art that adorned the compound wall of the varsity main campus at Kalady has been restored



to its pristine glory under the supervision of TG Jyothilal, Head of the Department of Painting. As

many as 20 students from the varsity, pursuing their undergraduate programmes in Fine Arts, joined him in this unique artistic endeavour. The conservation work entailed a detailed study of the mural, which revealed that old emulsion coating had turned grim over time while the pigment was in blister condition. It had also developed cracks in some places apart from the usual accumulation of dust and grime.

"Our job was to consolidate the pigments and improve the tonal quality of the paintings, which remained neglected. For this, we used the colours of yellow ochre and saffron red — two of the key colours used in Kerala-style fresco," says T. G. Jyothilal. The base was set with a coat of cement primer and exterior emulsion while the colours were spray-painted so as to maintain the high-relief mould. The team, which worked on a round-the clock-basis, took nearly a week to complete the restoration work.

The painting, a masterpiece creation of artist K. K. Suresh — a former faculty member with the Department of Painting at the varsity here, was showcased for public viewing in the academic year

1999-2000. Divided into 120 blocks of 10 ft, each of the block depicts various stories from the Indian mythology. Besides, selected scenes from the life of Adi Shankaracharya, 108 Karnas from Bharata's Natyasashtra and significant pieces of the famous Indian literary classics Kalidasa's Sakunthalam and Megha Sandesa, have also found a place in the painting. In 2000, the wall received a nomination to the Limca Book of Records for being the longest Mural Wall in the world.

Critical Juncture: Looking at Indian and Polish cultural collaborations

t was a rare meeting of minds at the Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit as curators and artists from Poland descended on the

"This is the continuation of a link which started in the 16th century. Even in the 19th century several Sanskrit texts were translated into the Polish language.

Indian languages and literature are taught in Polish universities. "I am happy that the Ministry of

Culture and National Heritage of Republic of Poland and Polish Institute in New Delhi have taken the initiative to organise the seminar in association with the varsity," said Vice-Chancellor of the Sanskrit University Dr M.C. Dileep Kumar.

Bird Sanctuary at Sanskrit varsity

eaving the traditional birding sites, birders are now flocking the Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit Kalady, thanks to its rich avian wealth.

The varsity campus is serene, green and home to a bird sanctuary named Poorna. As per the estimate

the park, houses about 30 species of birds and plant varieties. Varsity officials pointed out that the sanctuary highlighted the role of the campus as a shelter for local and migrating birds and in spreading awareness about the importance of birds in the environment. Some of the bird varieties often

spotted here includes Night Heron, Purple heron, Back Bittern and Brown Hawk Owl. The location often serves as a stopover for many migratory birds as well.

"The significance of the park, established in December last year, is that it promises to radiate onto the surrounding urban settlement and spread the bird population to the countryside," said M.C. Dileep Kumar, Vice Chancellor of the varsity. According to him, the system does not concern solely birds, but also addresses the elimination or reduction of threats linked to the survival of species and plants.

> "The students and staff together play a key role in maintaining the system, which has been declared as a plastic-free zone," the VC explained, adding that the varsity would take every step to maintain its habitat intact even while taking up the various development projects. Aiming to spread awareness, the varsity officials also plans to organise bird identification workshop for

students in the coming months. "Students of different schools would be invited to participate in the contest, identify birds and check with experts about their guesses.
