The Department of Sanskrit Sahitya is organizing a short term course in **Translation from Sanskrit** from 2018 March 28 onwards for four months in the evening at 3.30 pm on working days. Translating of hitherto unavailable translations of known Sanskrit texts into Malayalam or English is the main aim of this course. Preference will be given to the Sanskrit works from Kerala and all areas of Sanskrit may be selected for translation.

There will be classes on translation theories and practice and each and every participant has to submit at least on translation by the end of the course. Classes will be conducted by the faculty members of Sanskrit Sahitya as well as by invited experts in the field. Certificate will be provided at the successful completion of the course. Anybody, who is interested in Sanskrit and PG students, M.Phil and Research scholars in Sanskrit Sahitya, General, Nyaya, Vedanta, Vyakarana, Vedic Studies or other Sanskrit related subjects are eligible to attend the course. The total intake will be 25 and there will be regular classes in the Department of Sanskrit Sahitya for 90 hours which include lecture classes, demonstrations, case studies, assignments and creative translations.
