# **Title of the Practice: Learning Management System (LMS)**

### **Objectives of the Practice**

- 1. To provide online classes to the students to cover the curriculum during the Pandemic period.
- 2. To achieve the three cardinal principles of Education Policy viz., access, equity and quality.
- 3. To Bridge the digital divide among students.

### The Context

The gigantic outbreak of COVID 19 pandemic in the state forced the University to start the teaching learning process through online mode as per the instruction from the central/state government and the UGC. The IT wing has customized MOODLE Based LMS (an open source software) as per the requirements of the University and this has won 3rd position in Kerala e-Governance award's e-learning section.

#### The Practice

The LMS platform developed by the University, prior to the outbreak of COVID 19, was one of the best alternatives to continue the Teaching Learning process through online mode. This has been systematically implemented by providing frequent training to the faculty members.

#### **Evidence of Success**

The Internal Examination Grades and End Semester Examination grades of students of the University of all the Programmes shows that the LMS is a great success. The LMS has won 3<sup>rd</sup> position in Kerala e-Governance award's e-learning section, adding another feather in University's cap.

## **Problems Encountered and Resources Required**

- 1. The struggle for students to focus on the screen for long periods of time.
- 2. Lack of Internet connectivity/laptop/mobile phone.
- 3. Minimal physical interactions between students and teachers.
