The meeting started at 11 a.m. Dr.P.V.Ouseph, Dean, Faculty of Other Sanskrit Studies, SSUS, Kalady chaired the meeting.

The meeting of the 44<sup>th</sup> Academic Council of SSUS Kalady, held on 10.03.2017 had decided to restructure the syllabi of all P.G.Programmes and to implement the same from 2017 June admission onwards.

Accordingly, as part of the syllabus restructuring, the Board of Studies of Sanskrit Vedic Studies was held in the Centre as per Order No.Acd.B1/4206, 2005/SSUS, dated, 03.04.2017 at 11 a.m. According to new structure, the Post Graduate Programme should contain a total of 16 courses with 4 courses in each semester. The total weightage of the programme should be 64 credits.

This point was discussed in detail in the Board of Studies meeting and suggestions were received from the members of Board of Studies for restructuring the syllabi following the regulations as mentioned above. Finally, decision was taken in the Board meeting to prepare the new syllabus having 16 courses in 4 semesters with 64 credits in total.

The draft of the restructured syllabi was prepared and approved by the Board of Studies. The Board authorized Dr.K.A.Ravindran, the Co-ordinator of Centre for Sanskrit Vedic Studies to finalise the syllabi and submit it to the meeting of the Faculty for approval.

The meeting came to an end at 3 p.m.
