Indian aesthetic thought and practices have a long and complex history; diverse regional and linguistic traditions, performative and philosophicalstreams, social and spiritual influences have shaped its flows, and also, various layers of sedimentation. Some theorists explain Indian aestheticsas a confluence or as an ever evolving dialogue between the desi and margi traditions. Butsuch categorisations are not often adequate to fully account for or understand the local socio-political contexts, performative traditions, linguistic nuances and stylistic inflections. There is also the huge and sometimes overwhelming influence of western thinking and aesthetic theory that on the one, triggered new synergies at the local level, but on the other, also stifled local theorisation and historicizing.

Like other parts in India, the region of Kerala and Malayalam language too are no exception to these pan-Indian trends. Kerala has a long and rich tradition of art, performance, literature and music that draws from local, regional, national and global streams of thought, languages, theoryand practice. There has been a number of aesthetic discourses and theorization based on Indian aesthetic theory, and also in constant dialogue/argument with Western aesthetics. All these have shaped Kerala's aesthetic discourses through time, and also impacted upon its art and performance practices.

This Lecture Series is an attempt to understand the history and evolution of aesthetic thinking and writing in Kerala/Malayalam by looking at major thinkers and also theoretical influences. The lectures will focus on how the key theorists/thinkers negotiated local art practices, traditions, aesthetic understanding and thinkingwith Sanskritic or pan-Indian and Western aesthetic tradition/theory. The attempt will be to trace the history of the 'local' or 'vernacular' in its complex interface and negotiation with the regional, national and global. The first series will focus on Key Thinkers and Themes.

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on 18/10/2018 between Sahapedia (hereinafter referred to as "Sahapedia"), Uru Art Harbour (hereinafter referred to as "UAII") and Sri Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady (hereinafter referred to as "SSUS"). The three parties will hereinafter be collectively be referred to as "Project Partners."

In furtherance to the objects of all three PARTIES, as also in recognition of a shared commitment to the creation of a corpus of knowledge, the PARTIES have decided to enter into a partnership for the event titled "Uru Conversation Series: ലാവണ്യചിന്തയുടെ മലയാളധാരകൾ", translated into English as "Uru Conversation Series: Aesthetic Thought-The Malayalam Engagements."

- The event will be held at Uru Art Harbour, Kochi on Oct. 20, 21 and Nov. 10, 11, 2018. The final colloquium of the event will be hosted at a Biennale Venue in December 2018. The event will conclude in December 2018.
- The Curator of the "Uru Conversation Series: Aesthetic Thought-The Malayalam Engagements" is Dr. CS Venkiteswaran.
- There will be a minimum of eight speakers participating in the event.
- All presentations made by speakers as part of the "Uru Conversation Series: Aesthetic Thought-The Malayalam Engagements" will be recorded and edited in the audio-video format ('Series Video') by UAH. UAH will share a copy of unedited footage of the 'Series Video' within one week of each recording being made and the final edited version of the 'Series Video' within three months. UAH will get signed consent forms from all participants, as per Annexure I.
- SSSU will transcribe all presentations that are part of the event and share the transcripts with Sahapedia within three months of the conclusion of the event.
- Sahapedia will have the right to publish the 'Series Video' and its transcripts on its digital platform(s) as per Annexure II.
- · Sahapedia will financially support the event, up to a maximum of Rs. 2 lakh, by directly paying to the service providers on presentation of invoice/s. This support shall be toward:
 - Travel of resource persons, accommodation and tood as well as accommodation and food for 50 student parncipants

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- . Documentation cost, Sound system rent, Venue management and Local Travel
- . Print, Publicity and Stationery
- · This MoU will become effective on the date it is signed by all three PARTIES and will remain valid initially for 6 months, and may be renewed by mutual agreement to successive terms.
