

highlights of the programme was the poster exhibition conducted by the students.







National Seminar on Multiculturalism in Social Work Praxis: Critical Reflections

Number of participants:350+

The Department of Social Work, Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit (SSUS), Kalady or- ganised a National Seminar on **"Multiculturalism In Social Work Praxis: Crtitical Reflec- tions"** on $18^{th} - 19^{th}$ March 2016. Koottu – a one day meet of social work students and faculty of all the four centres (Thuravur, Thirur, Payyannur, Kaladi) under Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit was also held along with the National Seminar on 20th March 2016.

The National Seminar was inaugurated on 18th March by Dr M. C Dileep Kumar, Vice Chancellor, SSUS. Dr. Jose Antony (Head, Dept.of Social Work, SSUS) gave the Presidential Address and the felicitations were given by Mr. T S Suseelan (Finance Officer, SSUS), Dr. Vijaya Mohanan Pillai (Campus Director, SSUS) and Mr. K. K. Krishna Kumar (HOD [Theatre] and Syndicate Member, SSUS). Dr. Suchetha Nair (Pro Vice Chancellor, SSUS) released the Koottu Souvenir during the Inaugural function.

The National Seminar started on 18th March with an introductory talk on the Seminar theme by Dr Jose Antony (Head, Dept.of Social Work, SSUS). **Two keynote** speakers addressed the audience during the morning session. The first key note was on **Multiculturalism:** A **Critical Dis- course in Indian Context by** Adv. Flavia Agnes (Women Rights Activist & Director of Majilis, Mumbai). The second keynote address was on **Multiculturalism: Readings on Social Work Praxis by** Dr. Manoj Kumar Jha (Professor & Head, School of Social Work, University of Delhi). Two plenary sessions - **Multiculturalism in Development praxis & Health Praxis and Multiculturalism** – were held during the National Seminar. Dr. Fr. Prasant Palakkappillil (Principal, Sacred Hearts College, Thevara), Adv. C R Neelakandan (Social

Critic & Activist, Kochi), Dr. Aslesh O P, (Asst. Professor, Dept of Community Medicine, Government Medical College, Thrissur) and Dr. George Joseph (Senior Consultant of Psychiatry, Rajagiri Hospital, Kochi) were the resource persons during the two plenary sessions. A **panel session** on **Margin- alised Cultures** was held during the end of the seminar in which Mr Sunil Mohan (Independent Researcher, Alternative Law Forum, Bangalore), Dr Dilip G Diwakar (Asst. Professor, Dept of Social Work, Central University of Kerala, Kasaragod), Mr Rajendraprasad (Editor, Gothrabhoomi & Director, Thampu) and Mr Hamsa Jaisal (Researcher, Insight Project, Kerala Federation of the Blind, Thiruvananthapuram. Along with the keynote, plenary and panel sessions, **two parallel sessions** were held in which academic papers were presented by the seminar participants.

The two day National Seminar, attended by 350 participants – students, faculty, researchers and activists from various social work and social science disciplines and institutions across Kerala and India - deliberated on the intersections of culture involving different communities, sectors and concepts in the contemporary society. Forty two academic papers were presented during the Seminar. The National Seminar brought in the perspectives of academicians, activists, researchers, students, policy makers etc on the concept of multiculturalism thus contributing to the knowledge base on social work theory and practice.
