The 40th meeting of the Academic Council started with a silent prayer.

I. Introduction by the Chair

The Vice Chancellor extended warm welcome to all members to the 40^{th} meeting of the Academic Council.

Report of the Vice-Chancellor before the Academic Council

Good morning and welcome you all to 40th meeting of the Academic Council. I wish to remind you that our responsibility has become doubled as our departed former President and first person of our nation demanded from us. Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam was not just a President but great visionary, Philanthropist and intellect who could inspire thousands especially young people. His speeches and interactions in public realm will last forever in our mind. So this meeting is not just to remember him or record its condolence in his eternal departure, but wishes to take many

proactive decisions to keep his memory alive and be truthful to him. I request you to stand up for a while to pay tribute to him and to place on record the following.

"The Academic Council, while cherishing the fond memories Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, wishes to rededicate itself to the great responsibilities of leading this institution successfully and reaffirm our resolve to work together relentlessly, for the best interest of the institution. Also it places on record its utmost sorrow in his unexpected departure and share the pain of his loss with all the country men". I wish to extend my condolence to Sri. R.S. Gawai, former Governor of Kerala and Chancellor of the University. The following is the brief report of important events after the last session.

Admission

Almost all procedures for admission to UG and PG courses for the academic year 2015-16 has been completed. All Campus Directors, Heads of the Departments and Staff have worked in unison for the successful admission process.

Post creation

As decided in various meetings of the Syndicate, the creation of posts is indispensable for the smooth functioning of administrative and academic units. By our consistent demand, the Hon'ble Education Minister convened a meeting on 23-07-2015 with the officials on both sides to discuss our demand. Along with Syndicate members, Registrar and others, I could convince him of the need of creating new posts in the University and I expect a positive decision from the Government soon.

Strengthening of Regional Centres

Regional Centre, Payyannur

The foundation laying ceremony for the girls hostel at Regional Centre, Payyannur, which will be built with financial assistance of the UGC was held on 15-07-2015. Dr. M.K. Abdul Khader, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of Kannur University and myself jointly laid the foundation stone to mark our effort to strengthen Regional Centres.

Regional Centre, Koyilandy

Based on the direction of the Syndicate, a discussion was held in the Regional Centre with the Faculty and students along with the Syndicate members to decide on the shifting of PG classes to the new building of Orokonnumala campus and to conduct necessary maintenance work to the existing building urgently in order to continue classes there.

Meeting with students Union Representatives

With a motto of Green clean campus, the University convened a meeting of student's representatives on 28-07-2015 and all have agreed in principle to maintain the clean campus. Most of the students organizations have also informed their willingness to keep the agitation out of the Administrative block

Career Advancement/Placement of Teachers

The University could almost complete the processing of pending application of teachers under CAS Programme in various posts and eligible promotions have been awarded.

E-governance Programme

The Vice-Chancellor has attended a meeting of the monitoring committee of the GIMC (Government Implementation and Monitoring Committee) for implementation of e-Governance held at Thiruvananthapuram on 16-06-2015. 85 % of the 'As Is' Study for implementing e-governance programme in the SSUS has been completed.

RUSA Proposals

With pleasure and great privilege I would like to inform that the University is one among the four Universities in the State that has got grant for Rs. 20 crores under RUSA. The detailed project report for the sanctioned amount has been prepared and submitted for granting the project amount.

Inspection from Social Justice Department

Mr. Damodaran, member Social Justice Empowerment Department under the Ministry of Social Justice visited the University to inspect the facilities and amenities to SC/ST students in the University and registered his pleasure and satisfaction in the performance of the University in this field.

Retirement of Staff

The University has witnessed many retirements in the last month. Two Campus Directors – Dr. Damodaran Unni and Dr. Vijaya Kumar , three teachers – Dr. C.P. Vilasini, Dr. N.V. Kunjamma and Dr. Ramamoorthi, Joint Registrar - Smt. Soudamini K.G and two Class IV staff – Smt. Valsala and Smt. Vasanthi have completed the University service after a long and meritorious association with the University.

I wish to invite you all for constructive discussions based on the agenda of the meeting.

Discussion on the report of the Vice Chancellor – reg.

During the discussion about the report of Vice Chancellor Dr.V.G.Gopalakrishnan demanded clarification about MFA course in which the 3 specializations (Painting, Mural Painting and Sculpture) being offered. He suggested to offer the specialization only the last semester of the programme. Sri.Babu K, Lecturer and HOD in charge of Painting Department opined that specialization courses are to be offered in all semesters of the programme. After a detailed discussion, the Academic Council resolved to convene an urgent meeting of Board of Studies and Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences to define the core courses and optional courses of MFA programme. Also resolved to entrust the convener, Standing Committee on Academic & Research to verify the Syllabus of the programme before placing it in the Board of Studies.
