

DEPT. OF VYAKARANA

The Department of Sanskrit Vyakarana provides training for students in the traditional art of Vakyartha. Gatherings like Vakyartha Sabha, Vidvat Sadas etc. formed an integral part of philosophical and linguistic discussions in our tradition. Even today such gatherings aid in facilitating modern Sanskrit discussions, and especially in promoting vocal tradition of the language. Students are given ample tutoring each week under the expert guidance of scholars like Dr. K. Vishnu Namboothiri and Dr. Ch. Sathyanarayana Shastri. Students are asked to pick a topic from a shastra text and prepare themselves in the style of Vakyartha. Scholars then provide them with corrections, additions and regular assistance. A full-fledged Vakyartha Sabha is then conducted on the last Saturday of each month. The trained students are given an opportunity to showcase their understanding of the subject and skill in furthering the established theses in their respective shastras. Students also get an opportunity to watch invited scholars perform in the sabha and earn valuable feedback too. Each sabha is mapped out in such a way that theories of different disciplines like Nyaya, Vedanta, Sahitya, Jyotisha too gets discussed enabling students to gain rudimentary understanding in these fields as well.
