1.THE UNIVERSITY

The Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit was established in November 1993 by an Act of Kerala State Legislature, as an institution of higher learning, with particular focus on Sanskrit language and literature, Indology, Indian Philosophy, Indian Languages, Social Sciences and other related subjects. Kalady, the birth place of the great Indian Philosopher Adi Sankaracharya, which is located on the banks of river Periyar, is the headquarters of the University. Apart from the Main Campus at Kalady, the University offers Programmes at Regional Campuses at Payyannur, Koyilandy, Tirur, Thuravoor, Ettumanoor, Panmana and Thiruvananthapuram.

3. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

Eligibility for applying to M.A, M.Sc., MSW Programme is any Under Graduate degree (10+2+3) recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit. Those regular students under Choice Based Credit and Semester System of U.G. programme who have successfully completed and passed all the courses of I to IV Semesters (I to VI semesters for four year Degree Programme) and appearing for the final semester examination in April-May 2022 are also eligible to apply for the programmes offered, on the condition that they should produce the provisional /original degree certificate by 31.08.2022. All other candidates shall submit their proof of eligibility to the programme (including all relevant original certificates) at the time of admission. If the candidate has not submitted the qualifying certificate and relevant original certificate for PG Admission within the stipulated date, his/her admission will be cancelled without further notice.

4. SELECTION PROCEDURE AND OPTION FACILITY

- All eligible candidates who have applied against the notification for admission to PG Programme will be called for an Entrance Examination, and Aptitude test, as the case may be. The examination is intended to test the ability of the candidate to pursue the subject of study. The time allotted for each test is 2 hours and the test carries a maximum of 100 marks (unless specified).
- There will be separate entrance examinations for each Programme.
- Those who secure a minimum of 40% of Marks (unless specified) in the PG Entrance
 Examinations will be qualified for admission. A relaxation of 5% will be available for applicants belonging to SC/ST and differently abled categories.
- Candidates can write the PG Entrance Examinations at Campuses of their choice except for Bharathamayam, Mohiniyattam, Music, Painting, Theatre and Physical Education since these programmes have Aptitude test.
- The PG Entrance Examinations and Aptitude tests for Bharathamayam, Mohiniyattam, Music, Painting, Theatre and Physical Education Departments will be conducted only at Headquarters Kalady.
- If, after the candidates have exercised their option facility, five students are not available for Sanskrit Programmes and ten students are not available for non Sanskrit Programmes at a particular campus, then those particular Programmes will not be offered at those Campuses. Students who have opted for those campuses will be offered admission in nearby/other campus.
- The facility to opt for the choice of campus will be provided to the candidates after the publication of the rank list of entrance examination for each PG Programme.
- Candidates are strictly directed to opt for their choice within the stipulated time. If the
 candidates have not exercised their options within the stipulated time, their claim for admission
 will be cancelled and further request in this regard will not be considered under any
 circumstances.

- The candidates can apply for maximum of three Programmes regardless of the subjects they had taken in their graduate level (unless specified).
- Those candidates who have completed one PG programme in regular stream are not eligible for another PG programme, except for Music, Painting, Dance and Theatre. However, such students will not be eligible for any fee concession, hostel facilities, and contest in election.
- There will be no spot Admission for PG Programmes 2022

5. HOW TO REGISTER

Candidates seeking admission to the above P.G. Programmes shall register for Entrance Examination through online in the University Website www.ssus.ac.in before 22.04.2022. **The fee for Entrance Examination shall be paid through online only.**

Those who wish to appear for Entrance Examination for more than one subject of P.G. Programme should pay the Entrance Examination Fee separately for each Programme.

6. Submission of Print Copy of online Application

Printed copy of the online application along with Provisional/Original Degree certificate/ marksheets of I to IV semester Degree Programme (I-VI semester for four year Degree Programme) in the case of 2021-2022 batch of final semester students, Transfer Certificate, Migration Certificate, Eligibility/Equivalency certificate for candidates having degree from Universities outside Kerala State, Community/Disability/Other relevant Certificate for claim under reservation category (non-creamy layer certificate for reservation under OBC category, EWS certificate for

Economically Weaker Section etc.) and the other relevant Original documents and original fee receipt shall be submitted to the Heads of concerned Departments for the programme at University Campus, Kalady / Directors of Regional Campuses for programmes offered at Regional Campuses at the time of admission for verification. Reasonable time for producing Qualifying Certificates (Original/Provisional) will be provided only to those candidates appearing for the final semester/year degree examination of 2021- 2022 Academic year. If the candidate has not submitted the qualifying certificate and relevant original certificate for PG Admission within the stipulated date, his/her admission will be cancelled without further notice.

7. PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

All the P.G Programmes in the University are conducted under Outcome Based Teaching, Learning and Evaluation Scheme (OBTLE). The Programme Outcomes of Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit for the P.G Programmes are:

- o Self -directed and Life-long Learning

I. M.A. /M Sc. Degree Programme

Admission to various M.A & M Sc Programmes for the academic year 2022-23 is based on the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination to be conducted in May 2022. Aptitude and practical test will be conducted for M.A. Music, Bharathanatyam, Mohiniyattom and Theatre in addition to the Entrance Examination. No person shall be eligible for admission to a PG programme if he/ she is currently on the rolls of a PG programme in another subject/ discipline offered by the University. The transfer certificate shall be produced at the time of admission. Those who secure a minimum of 40% of Marks in the entrance examinations will be qualified for admission. A relaxation of 5% will be available for applicants belonging to SC/ST and differently abled categories.

Aptitude and practical test will be conducted for M.A. Music, Bharathanatyam, Mohiniyattom and Theatre in addition to the written test. Students who seek admission to Music shall undergo a practical test. Candidate shall have the eligibility to perform one Ata thala Varnam in two degrees of speed and a short raga alapana for Raga prescribed in the syllabus of BA Music degree course of this University. There will be aptitude and practical test for admission to MA Theatre and MA Dance (Bharathanatyam and Mohiniyattom).

The Post Graduate Degree programme consists of four semesters under OBTLE Scheme. Credit System is followed for the evaluation of the courses in each semester of M.A. / MSc Degree.

Credit System: - The total minimum credit for the M.A Programme will be 64 and for M Sc. Programme will be 66. The students are required to clear a pass minimum of 12 credits (3 courses) in a semester and to obtain the minimum pass grade for registering to the next semester. B- is required for a pass in each course. Each department will decide the number of core courses and elective courses in each discipline. Two of the elective courses will be Multidisciplinary. Multidisciplinary course I must be chosen from any of the Sanskrit Departments and course II from any other department. A student can take additional electives if he/ she desires. In each semester, students have to register for the elective courses from disciplines other than parent discipline within 10 days of commencement of the semester. More details in this regard can be obtained from the MA/MSc Regulation 2019 published in the University website www.ssus.ac.in.

A combination of the internal and the external evaluation is followed in the system. 50% of the credits will be for internal evaluation and the other 50% will be for the end- semester examination conducted by the University.

Evaluation and grading will be based on the 9 point grading system.

An average of B- (B minus) is the minimum pass grade. If a student fails in a course ie; if he/she gets 'F' then he/she should pursue that course again when it is offered subsequently. There will be no supplementary examination.

ii) Master of Social Work

Eligibility for applying to MSW Programme is a bachelor degree in any discipline (10+2+3) recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit. .Admission to the MSW programme will be on the basis of a Comprehensive Social Work Admission Test conducted by the University.

Those who have obtained an Under Graduate Degree , or are appearing for final semester Under Graduate Degree examinations are eligible to attend the Admission Test . A prospective student seeking admission to MSW is expected to have competencies in the following faculties and the admission test has to invariably test these aspects of aspirant.

Aptitude - to serve the society and to take up social work as a profession.

Knowledge - a general knowledge on society, social problems and development issues for the application of them in the the practices of social work and knowledge backgrounds to support the academic learning

Skill - for effective communication, for organizing and managing people and programs, and leading qualities.

Intellect - to competitively perform in academic activities

Language - Proficiency in English apart from other working Languages.

The admissions including the choice of the campus will be based on the final rank list prepared by the University, the option exercised by the candidate and according to the University regulations and government directions. 10% weightage (of the mark in the Common admission test) will be added to marks secured in the Common Admission Test to the candidates having Bachelor's degree in Social work as their eligibility while preparing the final rank list. A relaxation of 5% marks will be available for applicants belonging to SC/ST and differently abled categories on the eligibility for qualifying the admission test. The transfer certificates shall be produced at the time of admission.

No person shall be eligible for admission to a PG programme if he/ she is currently on the rolls of a PG programme in another subject/ discipline offered by the University. The transfer certificate shall be produced at the time of admission.

The Department of Social Work is established in 1995 and belongs to the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences. Department offers post graduate programme in Social work (MSW). The Social Work programme offers interdisciplinary academic and research possibilities that critically opens up local and global discourses on health, development and marginalization, gender, and family, identity, rights and justice. The field practicum component, which is an integral part of the MSW curriculum, offers opportunities for the students to spend time in close proximity with communities, NGOS and various social movements. Such close association lays the foundation for critical and alternative perspectives on one's own society. The course thus will provide the students with strong theoretical underpinnings and expose them to the dynamics and complexities of the social world.

The Social Work discipline and profession aims at planning and implementation of social policies, services and programmes needed to meet basic human needs and to support the development of human capacities and abilities. It facilitates change (1) within the individual in relation to his/her social environment; (2) of the social environment in its effect upon the individual; (3) of both the individual and social environment in their interaction. The ultimate aim of social work is to promote or restore a mutually beneficial interaction _inter', _intra' individual, and society in order to improve the quality of life for everyone.

The social work training and profession, despite having an existence of more than seventy five years in the country has progressed at snail's pace. It is still a yet to be developed profession and only very little effort has been made to make it indigenous or Indian. The profession still holds the theoretical and practical foundations of the west and has not made appropriate Indian adaptations. The picture is same in the context of Kerala and people consider it an alien profession. Hence an effort to acculturate and adapt the modern professional concepts and practices of social work to be conversant with the diverse sociocultural and political realities of South Asia is a long pending plea and needs a pioneering initiation and continuous effort. At Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit we are committed to nurturing an ever evolving discipline which is sensitive to the indigenous knowledge production, and at the same time open to the global initiatives in this area.

The Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit was initiated and formed for the preservation and promotion of social and cultural heritage of India in general and Kerala in specific. The methodological approach was Interdisciplinary collaboration and indigenization of the traditional and modern theoretical and academic discourses in knowledge generation and dissemination for the betterment of the society. The sociological and geopolitical ecology around the University is of a rural village inhabited by the middle and working class people. The Department makes use of all opportunities in engaging various extension activities in and around the campus. The post graduate programme offered by the Department (MSW) is recognized by the social work accreditation councils of UK, USA, Australia, Canada, and New Zealand. Our students get their recognitions and accreditations in these countries on the basis of the verification of the course modules they have done in the University and the field practicum they have done here in the programmes. There are a number of students who have got their professional career in social work in these countries and some of them also pursue their higher education programmes on the basis of the PG programmes offered by our department.

M.S.W programme consists of four semesters under OBTLE Scheme. There is internal and external evaluation. The curriculum consists of theory classes, field work, practical training, seminars, rural camps, study tours, dissertation etc. The general subjects of the course are:

- 1. Social Science perspectives and theories
- 2. Social Work concepts and Ideologies
- 3. Social work profession- Philosophy, methods and fields.
- 4. Human growth and Development
- 5. Human Behavior and Emotions
- 6. Social work methods
- 7. Introduction to Social Work Research
- 8. Qualitative and Quantitative research methods
- 9. Social Policy and Social Legislations
- 10. Development Communication
- 11. Development Administration
- 12. Counselling and Therapies
- 13. Planning and Implementation of Development Projects

Apart from these courses the students have to do the courses under the selected concentration stream from the following:

- A) Development Social Work Practices (DSWP)
- B) Health Social Work Practices (HSWP)
- C) Family Social Work Practices (FSWP)

The students also can choose from the elective courses offered by the Department and other Departments. More details in this regard can be obtained from the MSW regulations 2019 published in the University website: www.ssus.ac.in.

iii) Master of Fine Arts (Visual Arts)

A candidate seeking admission for the 2 year Master of Fine Arts Degree Programme shall fulfill the following condition.

- (a) Should have passed the Bachelor Degree in Fine Arts in concerned subject of any University recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady with a minimum of 55% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade in aggregate.
- (b) No person shall be eligible for admission to a P.G.Programme if he/she is currently on the rolls for a P.G.Programme in another discipline offered by the University.
- (c) A student should produce an equivalency certificate if he/she has a Degree from University outside Kerala State.
- (d) SC/ST candidates and differently abled candidates shall get 5% relaxation in marks as per rules.

Those regular students under Credit and Semester System of B.F.A. programme who have successfully completed I to VI Semesters and appeared for all the courses of the final semester Degree Examination in April-May 2022 are also eligible to apply for M.F.A. Programme on condition that they must produce Provisional Certificate by 31.08.2022.

The admission to the MFA Programme shall be made on the basis of written test, academic record and interview/portfolio/performance.

All eligible candidates applied for admission to MFA Programme will be called for an Entrance Examination / interview to be conducted in May/June 2022. The examination is intended to test the ability of the candidate to pursue the subject of study. The time allotted for written test is 1 hour and the test carries a maximum of 50 marks and portfolio presentation cum interview carries a maximum of 50 marks. The entrance test and aptitude test to candidates will be held in Main Campus at Kalady.

Total number of courses will be 28 and total credit of courses will be 86 under OBTLE Scheme. A combination of the internal and the external evaluation is followed in the system. 50% of the total marks will be for internal evaluation and the other 50% will be for the end- semester examination in the case of theory subjects and end semester display and presentation of works done by the students in the case of practical subjects. The end semester evaluation for display and presentation will be done by a panel of External Examiners. A student will be allowed to proceed to the next year only if, he/ she has cleared atleast 50% of all courses of two semesters taken together. Otherwise the student has to take admission again to the first semester.

Evaluation and grading will be based on the 9 point grading system.

An average of B- (B minus) is the minimum pass grade. For more details in this regard can be obtained from the MFA Regulation 2019 published in the University website www.ssus.ac.in.

iv) MPES

A candidate for admission to the two-year Master of Physical Education and Sports (M.P.E.S) Degree Programme shall fulfill the following conditions:

- 1. Should have passed the Bachelor Degree in Physical Education (B.P.E)/B.P.Ed /B.P.E.S of any university recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady OR have passed a post graduate degree in Physical Education of at least one year duration of an Indian or Foreign University or Board appointed by the Education Department of the State or Union Territory recognized by the Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady, with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate.
- 2. Those who are appearing for the final year degree is eligible to write the entrance test and attend the practical component as detailed in the selection procedure.
- 3. The transfer certificate shall be produced at the time of admission and the Migration certificate can be produced at a later date.
- 4. No person shall be eligible for admission to a P.G degree programme if he/she is currently on the Rolls for a P.G programme in another discipline offered by the University.
- 5. Should be below the age of 28 years as on 1st July of the concerned year. SC/ST candidates will be given the eligible relaxation. Age relaxation of one year per Inter University Participation will be given, limited to a maximum of three years.
- 6. Should be physically fit for daily heavy load of physical activities and should not have physical deformity or mental disability.
- 7. In the event of pregnancy during the programme, women students may be permitted to discontinue for a minimum period of 15 (fifteen) months and allowed to rejoin in the beginning of the same semester, whether summer or monsoon from where they discontinued, that immediately follows the period of break.

Those regular students under Credit and Semester System of (B.P.E)/B.P.Ed/B.P.E.S. programme who have successfully completed I to IV Semesters and appeared for all the courses of the final semester Degree Examination in April-May 2022 are also eligible to apply for MPES. Programme on condition that they must produce Provisional Certificate by 31.08.2022

Selection Procedure: The candidates shall be selected for admission from the rank list prepared on the basis of the following criteria.

a. Written Test (Based on B.P.E./B.P.Ed./B.P.E.S Syllabus)
b. Game Proficiency
c. Physical Fitness Test (AAHPERD youth fitness test)
d. Sports Achievement

Candidates should secure 50% marks in the selection test to be included in the rank list. General reservation rules applicable to post graduate degree course at the university departments shall be followed while admitting candidates from the rank list.

A relaxation of 5% will be available for applicants belonging to SC/ST.

I) P.G. Diploma in Translation and Office Proceedings in Hindi

Eligibility for admission to the P.G.Diploma in Translation and Office Proceedings in Hindi Programme shall be a Degree in any discipline recognized by this University. Candidates who discontinued a P.G. Programme shall not be admitted to the P.G. Diploma Programme. Students who undergo any regular P.G.Programme can seek admission to the P.G.Diploma Programme. There is no age restriction in admission. Students who are appearing for their final Degree examination can also apply on condition that they should produce the Provisional Degree Certificate by 31.08.2022

Duration of the Diploma programme shall be two semesters subject to maximum of three semesters. Instruction method shall include lectures, seminars, discussions, demonstrations and field studies in appropriate cases. There will be eight courses with four credits each. The total credit will be 32.

Evaluation and grading will be based on the 9 point grading system.

vi) P.G. Diploma in Wellness and Spa Management

Candidates who have passed BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery) Degree from an institution recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicine and shall possess a permanent registration in the respective council/Board of the concerned state, are eligible for admission.

- i. The Original certificates of the qualifying examination, Permanent Registration, Transfer Certificate and Migration Certificate shall be produced at the time of the admission. If the Migration Certificate is not produced at the time of admission, the same shall be submitted within a period of two months from the date of admission.
- ii. No person shall be eligible for admission to the Post Graduate Diploma Programme if he/she is currently on the Rolls for any academic programmes in any other subject/discipline offered in this University or in any other institution.
- iii. The maximum age for admission to P.G. Diploma in Wellness and Spa Management shall be 35 years.
- iv. Selection shall be made on the basis of the marks of the qualifying examination, Group Discussion, Physical fitness and Interview. The maximum marks will be 100, of which 50 marks for the qualifying examination, 20 marks for Group Discussion, 10 marks for physical fitness and 20 marks for interview.
- v. Group discussion and Interview shall be conducted by a committee consisting of Campus Director, Head of the Department of Ayurveda and an External Expert, nominated by the Head of the Department of Ayurveda. Candidates who have secured 50% of the total marks shall be eligible for admission (45% for SC/ST candidates)

vi. Number of Seats for the Post Graduate Diploma Programme shall be 5, out of which 2 seats are reserved for the outside state candidates. In the absence of eligible outside state candidates, the same shall be filled up by the eligible candidates from Kerala. Increase in the number of seats will be considered by the University as and when required. Outside state candidates shall produce proof of residence/nativity/domicile certificate from the competent authority along with the application.

Note: University reserves the right to make any change in the course content especially the optional subjects or withdraw a course either fully or partially, without assigning any reason whatsoever.

M.A, M Sc, M.S.W, M.P.E.S and MFA. Programmes are full time programmes and the students are barred from studying any other Programmes anywhere during the period of study.

8. RESERVATION OF SEATS

Reservation of seats for the categories of SC / ST/ OBC / OEC / EWS / blind / differentially abled / orphans / sports /NCC / NSS / Kalathilakam / Kalaprathibha / Sargaprathibha Chithraprathibha / Ex-service men / Kashmiri migrants / descendants of Keralites from Andaman Nicobar islands etc. will be extended as per relevant Government/University Orders, provided the candidates shall produce the necessary valid certificates to prove their eligibility at the time of admission.

Two seats over & above the sanctioned strength are reserved for transgender category. Reservation to Economically Weaker Section in the General Category will be permitted as per rules. The mandatory reservation quota will not affect the annual strength for this academic year.

If the candidates have not exercised their options within the stipulated time, their claim for admission will be cancelled and further request in this regard will not be considered under any circumstances. Allotment of various study centers/campus to candidates will be based on the rank obtained in the entrance examination and the order of preference of the candidate at the time of admission. Campus once allotted by the University will not be changed for the 1st Semester.

11. EXEMPTION FROM PAYMENT OF FEES

SC/ST candidates will be given exemption from the payment of tuition fee, special fee and examination fees, subject to the grant of concession by the SC/ST department of Government of Kerala. However they will have to remit the other fees listed in the fee structure at item **9** They also need to submit application for fee concession in the prescribed form to avail the exemption immediately after the admission.

Concessions under KPCR will be allowed to eligible candidates.

Candidates claiming fee exemption/concession shall produce proof of their claim at the time of admission.

12. HOSTEL FACILITY

Limited hostel facility is available for boys and girls at the Main Campus, Kalady as per Hostel Admission Rules.

13. MIGRATION CERTIFICATE

Candidates from other Universities will have to produce Migration Certificate not later than two months from the date of their admission.

14.RANK LIST

Subject-wise rank list of candidates based on the marks obtained in the entrance examination will be published in the University website/notice boards at Main Campus

and Regional Campuses and every reasonable effort shall be taken to intimate the date, time and venue of the aptitude test, group discussion, as applicable. Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate, Grade sheet, Provisional/Original degree Certificates, Caste/Community Certificates and such other certificates are to be produced at the time of interview for admission. Candidates are advised to check the University website/notice boards either at the Main Campus or at any of the Regional Campuses for the date, time and venue of the aptitude test, group discussion, as applicable, and the interview at their own interest. **University will not be responsible for the non-receipt of intimation.**

15. REGISTRATION OF APPLICATION AND DISQUALIFICATION OF CANDIDATES

Applications which do not contain any of the enclosures specified in item # 6 above (at the time of admission), are liable to be rejected summarily. Attempt to canvass or influence the authorities, in any manner will warrant disqualification.

16. Last Date

The last date for submitting online application is 22.04.2022.

17. INSTRUCTIONS REGARDING THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

Entrance Test will be commenced from 05.05.2022. Schedule of entrance test/interview will be intimated later through University website.

- i. The maximum time allotted for each examination shall be 2 hours (unless specified).
- ii. Candidates will be allowed to appear only for the subject/subjects for which he/she has submitted the application form to the University.
- iii. Candidates are advised to be present in the examination hall 15 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- iv. The hall ticket should be produced for verification during each examination. No candidate will be a llowed to take the examination without his/her hall ticket.
- v. Recent Passport size Photograph of the candidate in the application and hall ticket should be duly attested by a Gazetted officer.
- vi. The hall ticket is to be signed by the candidate in the presence of the invigilator.
- vii. Candidates will not be allowed to take the examination if they arrive after 20 minutes from the commencement of the examination.
- viii. Candidates found copying or resorting to any unfair means will be disqualified.
- ix. Candidates are advised to use blue/black ink only for writing the examination.
- x. Special care should be taken while filling the details relating to the number, campus, subject etc. in t he answer sheet.
