Hard copy of the online application along with relevant original certificates shall be submitted only at the time of admission before the HoD / Campus Directors concerned for verification.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Eligibility for applying to PG Programme is any Under Graduate degree (10+2+3) recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit. Those regular students under Choice Based Credit and Semester System of U.G. programme who have successfully completed and passed all the courses of I to IV Semesters (I to VI semesters for four year Degree Programme) and appearing for the final semester examination in April-May 2024 are also eligible to apply for the programmes offered, on the condition that they should produce the provisional/original degree certificate by 31.08.2024. All other candidates shall submit their proof of eligibility to the programme (including all relevant original certificates) at the

time of admission. Transfer certificate shall be produced at the time of admission and the migration certificate shall be produced at a later date. If the candidate has not submitted the qualifying certificate and relevant original certificate for PG Admission within the stipulated date, his/her admission will be cancelled without further notice. Those candidates who have completed one PG programme in the regular stream can also apply for additional PG and are eligible for admission. But they are not eligible for any fee concession, hostel facilities and the right to contest in University Elections.

i) <u>M.A.& M.Sc</u>

Admission to various M.A. & M.Sc Programmes for the academic year 2024-25 is based on the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination expected to be conducted in April/May 2024. Aptitude and practical test will be conducted for M.A.Music, Bharathanatyam, Mohiniyattom and Theatre in addition to the Entrance Examination.

ii) MSW

Eligibility for applying to MSW programme is a bachelor degree in any discipline (10+2+3) recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit. Admission to the MSW programme will be on the basis of the Comprehensive Social Work Admission Test conducted by the University. Those who have obtained an Under Graduate Degree, or are appearing for final semester Under Graduate Degree examinations are eligible to attend the Admission Test. A prospective student, seeking admission to MSW is expected to have competencies in the following faculties and the admission test has to invariably test these aspects of aspirant.

Aptitude - to serve the society and to take up social work as a profession.

Knowledge - a general knowledge on society, social problems and development issues for the application of them in the practices of social work and knowledge backgrounds to support the academic learning

Skill - for effective communication, for organizing and managing people and programs, and leading qualities.

Intellect - to competitively perform in academic activities

Language - Proficiency in English apart from other working Languages.

The admissions including the choice of the campus will be based on the final rank list prepared by the University, the option exercised by the candidate and according to the rules and regulations of the University/Government. 10% weightage (of the mark in the Common admission test) will be added to marks secured in the Common Admission Test to the candidates having Bachelor's degree in social work as their eligibility while preparing the final rank list. A relaxation of 5% marks will be available for applicants belonging to SC/ST, Differently Abled and Transgender categories on the eligibility for qualifying admission test.

iii) MFA

A candidate seeking admission for the two year Master of Fine Arts Degree Programme shall fulfill the following conditions.

- Should have passed the Bachelor Degree in Fine Arts in the concerned subject of any
 University recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady, with a
 minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate. SC/ST candidates,
 Differently abled and Transgender categories candidates are eligible for 5% marks
 relaxation in the qualifying admission test.
- A student should produce an equivalency certificate if he/she has a degree from universities outside of Kerala State.

iv) MPES

A candidate seeking admission to the two-year Master of Physical Education and Sports (M.P.E.S) Degree Programme shall fulfill the following conditions:

1. Should have passed the Bachelor Degree in Physical Education B.P.E / B.P.Ed / B.P.E.S of any university recognized by Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady, **OR** have passed a post graduate degree in Physical Education of at least one year duration of an Indian or Foreign University or Board appointed by the Education Department of the State or Union Territory recognized by the Sree Sankaracharya University of Sanskrit, Kalady, with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate.

- 2. Those who are appearing for the final year degree is eligible to write the entrance test and attend the practical component as detailed in the selection procedure.
- 3. The Transfer Certificate shall be produced at the time of admission and the Migration certificate can be produced at a later date.
- 4. Should be below the age of 28 years as on 1St July of the concerned year. SC/ST candidates will be given the eligible relaxation. Age relaxation of one year per Inter University Participation will be given, limited to a maximum of three years.
- 5. Should be physically fit for daily heavy load of physical activities and should not have physical deformity or mental disability.
- 6. **Selection Procedure**: The candidates shall be selected for admission from the rank list prepared on the basis of the following criteria.
 - Written Test (Based on B.P.E. / B.P.Ed/ 50 marks
 B.P.E.S Syllabus)
 - Game Proficiency 25 marks
 - Physical Fitness Test (AAHPERD youth

 15 marks
 fitness test)
 - Sports Achievement 10 marks
 - Total 100 marks

Candidates should secure 50% marks in the selection test to be included in the rank list. General reservation rules applicable to post graduate degree programme at the university departments shall be followed while admitting candidates from the rank list. A relaxation of 5% will be available for applicants belonging to SC/St and Transgender category.

v) Multidisciplinary Dual Main Masters Programme in Disaster Management

Multidisciplinary Dual Main Masters Programme in Disaster Management is oriented in the OBTLE (Outcome Based Teaching, Learning and Evaluation) system, with a minimum credit requirement of 92 to complete the programme. The Programme is designed in such a way that by the end of the two years the students will be able to attain necessary skills and comprehensive knowledge of scientific, social and technical aspects to conceptualize and address disaster situations. The students who enroll in the Multidisciplinary Dual Main

Master's Programme in DM under a specific associating Department will subsequently be enabled to choose specialization and combination of allied courses from other associating Departments. This programme is envisaged in such a way as to award dual main degrees in four separate categories with respective specialisations.

- MSc in Geography and Disaster Management.
- MSc in Psychology and Disaster Management.
- MA in Sociology and Disaster Management.
- Masters in Social Work and Disaster Management.

Number of seats available for this programme will be 40 (10 seats in each specialisation).

Admission to the Multidisciplinary Dual Main Masters Programme in Disaster Management will be on the basis of a common entrance examination conducted by the University. Those who have obtained an Under Graduate Degree, or are appearing for the final semester Under Graduate Degree examination are eligible to attend the entrance examination. Those who secure a minimum of 40% marks in the entrance examination will be qualified for admission. A relaxation of 5% will be available to applicants belonging to SC/ST, Differently Abled and Transgender category. Admission, including the choice of the discipline, will be based on the final rank list prepared by the University according to the existing university regulations and government directions. The admissions will be made to the associating teaching departments. The maximum intake capacity to each associating department shall be ten seats.

vi) P.G. Diploma in Translation and Office Proceedings in Hindi

Eligibility for admission to the P.G.Diploma in Translation and Office Proceedings in Hindi Programme shall be a Degree in any discipline recognized by this University. Candidates who discontinued a P.G. Programme shall not be admitted to the P.G.Diploma Programme. Students who undergo any regular P.G.Programme can seek admission to the P.G. Diploma Programme. There is no age restriction in admission. Students who are appearing for their final Degree examination can also apply.

vii) P.G.Diploma in Wellness and Spa Management.

Candidates who have passed BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery)

Degree from an institution recognized by the Central Council of Indian Medicine and shall possess a permanent registration in the respective Council/Board of the concerned state, are eligible for admission. The Original certificates of the qualifying examination, Permanent

Registration, Transfer Certificate and Migration Certificate shall be produced at the time of the admission. If the Migration Certificate is not produced at the time of admission, the same shall be submitted within a period of two months from the date of admission. No person shall be eligible for admission to the Post Graduate Diploma Programme if he/she is currently on the Rolls for any academic programmes in any other subject/discipline offered in this University or in any other institution. Maximum age for admission to the Post Graduate Diploma in Wellness and Spa Management is 35 years. Selection shall be made on the basis of the marks of the qualifying examination, Group Discussion, Physical fitness and Interview. The maximum marks will be 100, of which 50 marks is for the qualifying examination, 20 marks for Group Discussion, 10 marks for physical fitness and 20 marks for interview. Group Discussion and Interview shall be conducted by a committee consisting of Campus Director, Head of the Department of Ayurveda and an External Expert, nominated by the Head of the Department of Ayurveda. Candidates who have secured 50% of the total marks shall be eligible for admission (45% for SC/ST and differently abled candidates).

Number of Seats for the Post Graduate Diploma Programme shall be 5, out of which 2 seats are reserved for outside state candidates. In the absence of eligible outside state candidates, the same shall be filled up by the eligible candidates from Kerala. Increase in the number of seats will be considered by the University as and when required. Outside state candidates shall produce proof of residence/nativity/domicile certificate from the competent authority along with the application.

Programme Outcomes of the University for the P.G.Programmes

All P.G. Programmes, in the university, is conducted under OBTLE scheme (Outcome Based Teaching, Learning and Evaluation) and the programme outcomes are.

- 1. Critical Thinking
- 2. Communication
- 3. Self –directed and Life-long Learning
- 4. Ethics

Those candidates who have completed one PG programme in the regular stream can also apply for P.G and are eligible for admission. But they are not eligible for any fee concession, hostel facilities and the right to contest in University Elections.

SELECTION PROCEDURE AND OPTION FACILITY

- All eligible candidates who have applied against this notification for admission to PG Programme will be called for an Entrance Examination, and Aptitude test, as the case may be.
- There will be separate entrance examinations for each Programme. Those who secure a minimum of 40% of Marks (50% for MSW and MPES) in the PG Entrance Examinations will be qualified for admission. A relaxation of 5% will be available for applicants belonging to SC/ST, Differently Abled and Transgender categories.
- Candidates can write the PG Entrance Examinations at Campuses of their choice.
 The PG Entrance Examinations and Aptitude tests for Bharathamayam,
 Mohiniyattam, Music, Painting, Theatre and Physical Education Departments will be conducted only at Headquarters, Kalady.
- If, after the candidates have exercised their option facility, five students are not
 available for Sanskrit Programmes and ten students are not available for non
 Sanskrit Programmes at a particular campus, then those particular
 programmes will not be offered at those Campuses. Students who have opted
 for those campuses will be offered admission in nearby/other campus.
- The candidates can apply for maximum **of three Programmes** regardless of the subjects they had taken in their graduate level (unless specified).
- There will be no spot/lateral entry Admission for PG Programmes 2024.

HOW TO REGISTER

Candidates seeking admission to the above P.G. Programmes shall register for Entrance Examination through online in the University Website www.ssus.ac.in before 07.04.2024. The fee for Entrance Examination shall be paid through online mode only.

Documents to be produced at the time of Admission

Printed copy of the online application along with Provisional/Original Degree certificate/ marksheets of I to IV semesters (three year Degree Programme), I-VI semester for four in the case of 2023-2024 batch of final semester year Degree Programmes **Transfer Certificate,** Migration Certificate, Community/Disability/other students), relevant Certificate for claim under reservation category (non-creamy layer certificate for reservation under OBC category, EWS certificate for Economically Weaker Section etc.) and the other relevant Original documents and original fee receipt shall be submitted to the Heads of concerned Departments for the programme at University of Regional Campuses for programmes offered at Campus, Kalady / Directors Regional Campuses at the time of admission for verification. Reasonable time for producing Qualifying Certificates (Original/Provisional) will be provided only to those candidates appearing for the final semester/year degree examination in 2023- 2024 Academic year.
