## SREE SANKARACHARYA UNIVERSITY OF SANSKRIT, KALADY REGULATIONS ON ELIGIBILITY AND CAS PROMOTION CRITERIA FOR TEACHERS AS PER UGC REGULATIONS 2018

#### **NOTIFICATION**

Based on the decision of 53<sup>rd</sup> Academic Council meeting of the University held on 16.03.2022 and U.O No. IQAC/CAS/API/SSUS/2019 dated 09.06.2022, University hereby make the following regulations on the Eligibility and CAS Promotion Criteria for teachers as per UGC Regulations, 2018.

- 1. This shall come into force w.e.f 18.07.2018
- **2**. As per Clause 6.3 of UGC Regulations 2018, option given to teachers to apply for placement under CAS of UGC Regulations 2010 until 17.07.2021 (ie., 3 years from the date of notification of the Regulations 2018).
- **3**. Promotion claims in r/o teachers who become eligible for promotion under CAS of UGC on or after 18.07.2021, shall be governed by the provisions of these regulations.
- 4. The Assessment of the performance of the University teachers for the CAS promotion will be based on the following criteria:
  - 1. Teaching-Learning and Evaluation:

The commitment to teaching based on observable indicators such as being regular to class, punctuality to class, remedial teaching and clarifying doubts within and outside when the need arises, etc. Examination and evaluation activities like performing of examination supervision duties, question papers setting for University examination, participation in the evaluation of examination answer scripts, conducting examinations for internal assessment as per the schedule to be announced by the institution at the beginning of each Academic Session and returning and discussing the answers in the class

2. Personal Development related to Teaching and Research Activities:

Attending orientation/refresher/methodology courses, development of econtents and MOOC's, organising seminar/conference/workshop/ presentation of papers and chairing of sessions/guiding and carrying out research projects and publishing the research output in national and international journals, etc.

- 3. Administrative Support and Participation in Students' Co-curricular and Extracurricular Activities.
- 5. The Teachers shall submit to the University an annual self-appraisal report in the prescribed proforma. The report should be submitted at the end of every academic year to the IQAC. The teacher should provide documentary evidence for the claims

made in the annual self-appraisal report, which is to be verified by the HoD/Teacherin-charge. The submission should be through HoD/Teacher-in-charge.

- 6. University shall issue a general circular twice a year, inviting applications for the CAS promotion from the eligible candidates.
- 7. A teacher who wishes to be considered for promotion under the CAS may submit in writing to the University, within 3 months in advance of the due date, that he/she fulfils all the requirements under the CAS and submit to the University the Assessment Criteria and Methodology Proforma/PBAS supported by all credentials as per the Assessment Criteria and Methodology guidelines set out in these Regulations.
- 8. If a candidate applies for promotion on completion of the minimum eligibility period and is successful, the date of promotion shall be from that of minimum period of eligibility.
- 9. If however, the candidate finds that he/she would fulfil the CAS promotion criteria at a later date and applies on that date, and is successful, his/her promotion shall be effected from that date of the candidate fulfilling the eligibility criteria.
- 10. In any case, CAS promotion will not be granted on a date prior to the date of application.
- 11. The candidate who does not succeed in the first assessment, he/she shall have to be reassessed only after one year. When such a candidate succeeds in the eventual assessment, his/her promotion shall be deemed to be one year from the date of rejection.
- 12. For the promotion under the CAS, the applicant teacher must be on the role and in active service of the University on the date of consideration by the Selection Committee.
- 13. The teachers should submit 5 copies of Proforma for PBAS and supporting documents
- 14. The applications and the PBAS formats are to be signed by the applicant and the HoD concerned, with date.
- 15. The applications for CAS by HoD's and Campus Directors are to be forwarded by the Vice Chancellor
- 16. Applications and PBAS without signature, date and attestation by the authority concerned will be rejected.
- 17. The Eligibility and CAS Promotion Criteria, Applicant Summary Sheets and Proforma for Annual Self Appraisal Report for Perfoma Based Appraisal System shall be as provided in the Annexure to these regulations.
- 18. All other conditions specified in the UGC Regulations 2018 with regard to CAS placement of University Teachers shall apply.

  - a. Completed Refresher/ Research Methodology Course/ Workshop/ Syllabus Up-gradation Workshop/ Training Teaching-Learning-Evaluation, Technology Programmes/ Faculty Development Programmes of at least one week (5days) duration,

OR

- b. Taken one MOOCs course (with e-certification)
  - OR
- c. Development of e-contents in four quadrants/ MOOC's course during the assessment period; and
- Published one research publication in the peer-reviewed journals or UGC- listed journals during assessment period. (In the case of traditional or professional fine arts faculties, participation in one International, National or State level Performance/ Exhibitions/ Contributions in the relevant field may be considered as equivalent)

## **CAS Promotion Criteria:**

A teacher shall be promoted if;

- 1. He/ She gets a 'satisfactory' or 'good' score in the annual performance assessment reports of at least three/ four/ five of the last four/ five/six years of the assessment period as the case may be (as provided in Appendix, Table I), and;
- 2. The promotion is recommended by the Screening-cum-Evaluation Committee.

Peer-Reviewed or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list) :

i Paper in refereed journals without impact factor -5 Points

ii Paper with impact factor less than 1 -10 Points

- iii Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 -15 Points
- iv Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 -20 Points
- v Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 -25 Points
- vi Paper with impact factor > 10-30Points
  - i.a Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.
- i.b More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the

First/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors.

#### NOTE 2:

Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

#### **NOTE 3:**

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint Supervision of the research student the formula shall be 70% of total score for supervisor and 30% for Co-supervisor. Supervisor and Co-supervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of 5(b). Policy Document and 6. Invited lectures/Resource Person/ Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.
- The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
